Dear BHS Families:

At Beaufort High School we strive to create opportunities to help our Eagles soar in all things. As we approach the conclusion of the first quarter, we are excited to announce the start of our Eagles' Academic Success Time program (EAST), which is available to all students in grades 9-12. The purpose of the EAST program is to provide students with after school tutoring and remediation in core academic subjects as well as assistance in preparation for our state End of Course (EOC) examinations.

The EAST program is free to all participants and will begin the week of October 26, 2020. Certified teachers are available to serve our students whose grades are below "70", and/or those whose MAP scores fall in the lower performance quartile, as well as our ESOL students. Additionally, tutoring support will be provided to current second, third and fourth year students needing credit recovery to achieve course requirements for graduation.

Currently, the EAST program will be held weekly Monday through Thursday from 3:45 p.m. – 5:45 p.m. We will begin operating in a hybrid fashion, allowing students to receive tutoring virtually via Zoom but also providing the option to attend tutoring face to face on their designated A or B day. Please note that transportation is *not* provided for face to face attendance; students must depart campus no later than 6:00 p.m each day following the conclusion of EAST. Regardless of the format students are with us, we expect that they remain engaged in an academic manner for the entirety of their session.

Registration for the EAST program is required for all student participants. At this time, participation is limited to the first 100 students to sign up; students who sign up once participation caps are reached will be placed on a waiting list, and added to the program as space allows. Please use the link provided to complete the application electronically.
