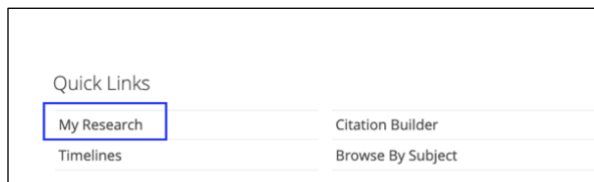


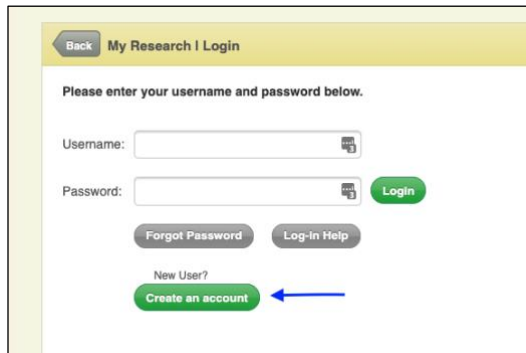
## HOW TO CREATE A MY RESEARCH ACCOUNT

This is a one-time setup. Once you complete the steps below, you will be able to save articles, media, and citations directly to **My Research** in Student and Advanced. If you have *eBooks*, this account also allows students to save *eBooks* to 'Favorites' and easily access notes and annotations on books from any device!


1. Log in to *World Book Online*. Login method varies by account. If you are not sure the method your school or library uses, email [slhelp@worldbook.com](mailto:slhelp@worldbook.com), [training@worldbook.com](mailto:training@worldbook.com), or contact your Educational Sales Consultant.
2. Enter *Student* or *Advanced*.
3. Click **My Research**. In *Student* this is found on the home page under **Quick Links**. In *Advanced* this is found under the **Research and Resources** menu.



4. Select **Create an account**.



5. Complete the form and click **Submit**.
