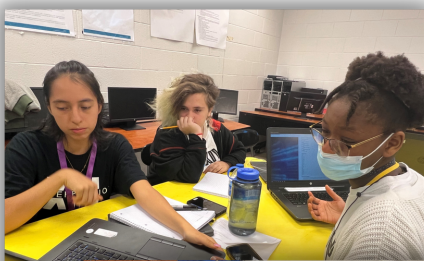

This project required students to stay under an assigned budget, complete a written design brief and present their final product to the class.



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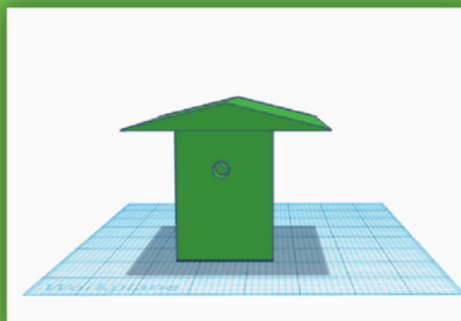
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TinkerCAD
